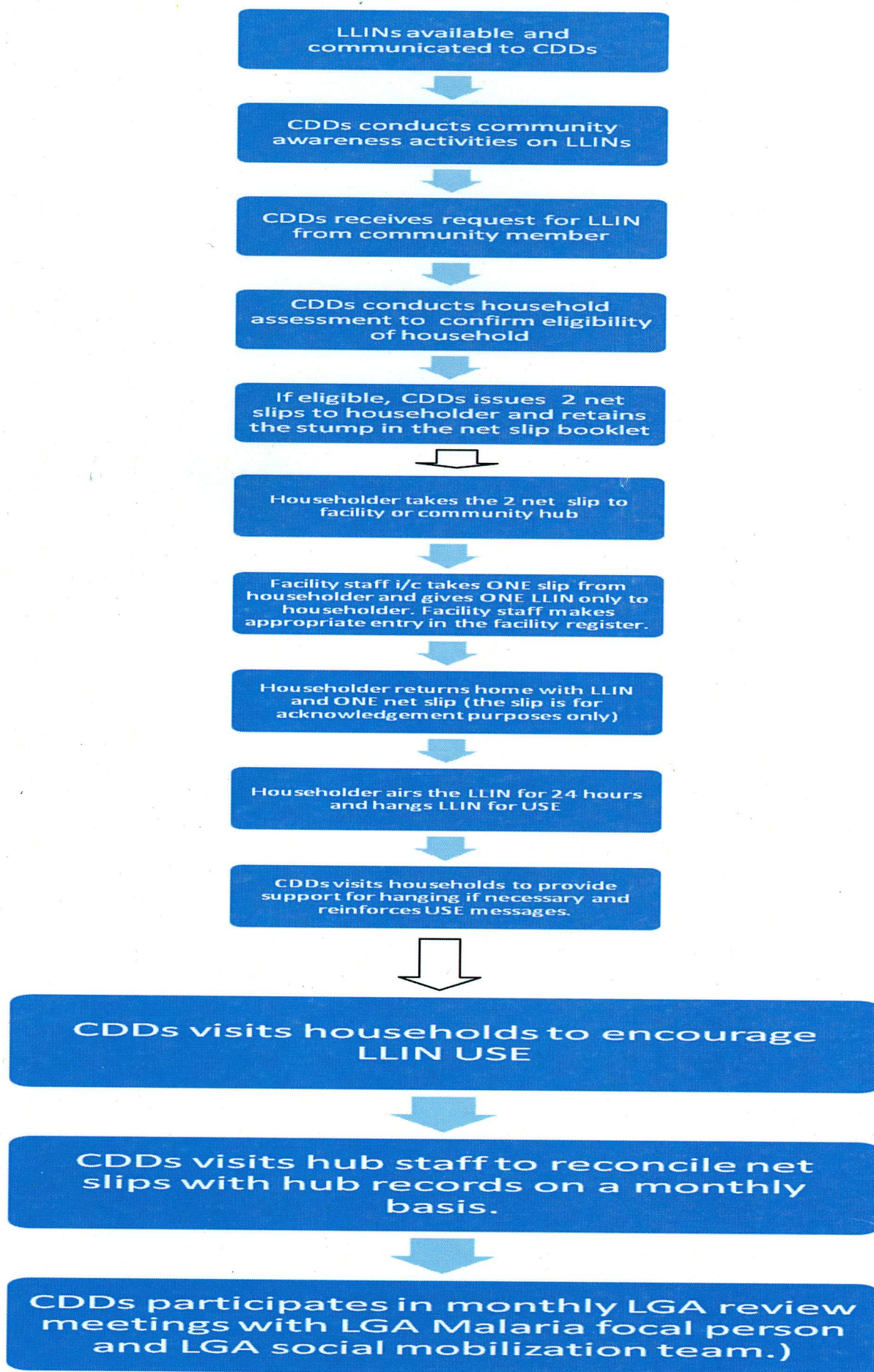


COMMUNITY LLIN DISTRIBUTION JOB AID

PROCEDURE FOR LLIN DISTRIBUTION THROUGH COMMUNITY ORIENTED RESOURCE PERSONS (CDDs)

1. LLIN availability is communicated to CDDs (CDD, volunteers etc) by health facility staff
2. CDDs and WDC conducts community awareness activities within the community
3. CDDs receives request for LLIN from community member
4. CDDs conducts household assessment to confirm eligibility of household
5. If eligible, CDDs issues 2 net slips to householder and retains the stump in the net slip booklet
6. Householder takes the 2 net slip to facility or community hub
7. Facility staff i/c takes ONE slip from householder and gives ONE LLIN only to householder. Facility staff makes appropriate entry in the facility register.
8. Householder returns home with LLIN and ONE net slip (the slip is for acknowledgement purposes only)
9. Householder airs the LLIN for 24 hours and hangs LLIN for USE
10. CDDs visits households to provide support for hanging if necessary and reinforces USE messages.
11. CDDs visits households to encourage LLIN USE
12. CDDs visits hub staff to reconcile net slips with hub records on a monthly basis.
13. CDDs participates in monthly LGA review meetings with LGA Malaria focal person and LGA social mobilization team.

COMMUNITY DISTRIBUTION ALGORITHM



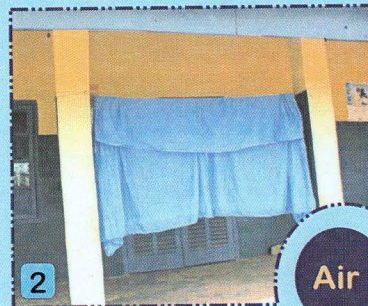

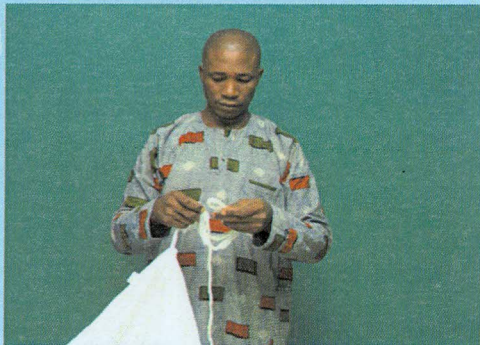
Tips on how to **HANG** the **NET (LLIN)**



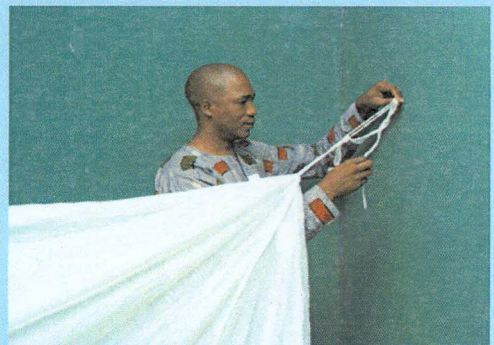
1 When newly opened, air for 24 hours under a shade



2 Identify and nail the points to hang net



3 Tie one end of a rope to the corners of the net



4 Tie the other end of the rope to the nail



5 When sleeping under the net, make sure the edges are well tucked-in



6 When not in use, gather the lower ends and fold up the net above the bed and sleeping area
